

Supplies for Fourth Grade, September 2009:

- One pencil pouch or box, containing:
- Package of pencils
- Glue sticks
- Small scissors
- Ruler (with both metric and standard marks)
- Green pen for editing and correcting
- Erasers
- Black sharpie pen, fine point
